2020 - 2021







2021-22

1) The Green Mizoram Day, 2021 was observed on 11.06.2021 by planting of **new 84 Saplings** in the College Campus. 30 NSS Volunteers (Male - 17 and Female - 13) participated.



2) On 31.01.2022, NSS Units, Govt. Khawzawl College successfully organized an Awareness Campaign on "Harmful Effects of Firecrackers" in Khawzawl Town.

The Campaign was organized under the chairmanship of Mr. K. Lalkulhpuia, NSS Programme Officer at three places such as Vengthar Chhipchhuan Bazar, Zuchhip Veng Jubilee Kawn and Zaingen Veng Bazar.
