College Activity Report

2019-2020

NSS ACTIVITIES:

1. Blood donation award was given to for 41 units. 3rd price was awarded to Govt. Khawzawl College NSS by Association for voluntary blood donation on 14th June 2019 by Voluntary Blood Donation Association Champhai.
2. Organized cleanliness drive and collecting plastic waste at Mualvawm Field on 24th Jan 2019. 67 volunteers participated.
3. Organized cleanliness work at the campus and mualvawm field khawzawl on 9th Aug 2019. 73 volunteers participated.
4. On 14th August 2019, Cleanliness Work was organized at the Mualvawm field by clearing of weeds in the surrounding Areas. 73 volunteers participated.
