

# **Govt. Khawzawl College**

## **College Activity Report**

### **2021-2022**

#### **NSS Activities:**

##### Blood Donation:

1. On 11<sup>th</sup> Feb 2022, in collaboration with office of the District Election Officers, Khawzawl District, Voluntary Blood Donation Camp was organized in the College Multipurpose Hall. 90 units (Male-55 and Female-35) were donated. On 31<sup>st</sup> January 2022, NSS units, Govt. Khawzawl College successfully organized an Awareness Campaign on “Harmful Effects of Firecrackers” in Khawzawl Town.
