Introduction



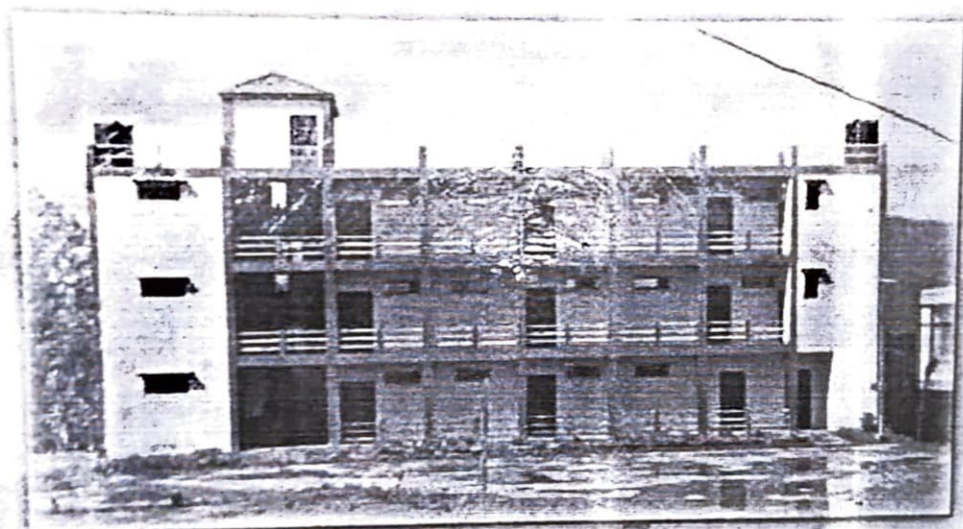
