Summary Reports of MoU signed between Govt. Khawzawl College & various other organizations & institutions between 2017-2022

- 1. Govt. Khawzawl College on 27th June, 2022 signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Dept. of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, Khawzawl Wildlife Division in order to work together on a project called "Green Campus Initiative" & to generate environmental awareness among the two main stakeholders the students and the staff members of the institution. The MoU will remain in effect until it is terminated in mutual agreement by both the parties While Govt. Khawzawl College agreed to perform the roles of providing land & required assistance for the execution of and maintenance of tree plantation, Dept. of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, Khawzawl Wildlife Division agreed to perform the roles of organizing environmental and fire prevention awareness programmes and climate change sensitization programmes for the students, providing opportunity for job experiences for students and transferring and rehabilitating of ex-situ collections from natural habitat. The MoU was signed in the presence of Mr. K. Ziona, Principal, Govt. Khawzawl College, Lalruatpuia, Assistant Professor, Dept. of Mizo, Govt. Khawzawl College, H. Vanlalhruaia, Head, Dept. of Economics & Head, Environment Management Committee and Divisional Forest Officer, Dept. of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Khawzawl District.
- 2. On 7 June, 2022 a MoU was signed between Govt. Khawzawl College & Office of the District Urban Development Officer in the presence of Mr. K. Ziona, Principal, Govt. Khawzawl College, Mr. Joseph Vanlalnghaka, Assistant Professor & Head, Dept. of History, Govt. Khawzawl College & Mr. Ngurthansanga, District Urban Development Officer, Khawzawl District & it will remain in effect until it is terminated in mutual agreement by both the parties. Both the parties signed the MoU in order to work together on a project referred to as "Swachhta Mission" & to organized awareness on Cleanliness among the people of Khawzawl and to make Khawzawl "The Cleanest City" in Mizoram. While Govt. Khawzawl College agreed to perform the roles of providing the workforce for the activity organized by the Office of the District Urban Development Officer, Khawzawl district and to organize awareness campaign on Cleanliness while Office of the District Urban Development Officer agreed to provide required fund for the activity.
- 3. On 25th February, 2022, Goyt. Khawzawl College signed a MoU with Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Khawzawl for a period of two years which will be reviewed after the end of two years as mentioned in MoU. The two parties Goyt. Khawzawl College & Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Khawzawl agreed to work together on conducting activities regarding cooking, food preserving and food processing and also agreed to render free service for the benefit of the female students and Goyt. Khawzawl College agreed to conduct a week-long classes on food processing, cooking and food preservation in the college campus and Goyt. 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- 4. Govt. The main purpose of signing the MoU was to work together on a project referred to as "Electoral Literacy Campaign & Disaster Management" and to create awareness on voting education within the area of 22-Tuichang Constituency and to provide awareness campaign on Disaster Management among the people of Khawzawl district. While Govt.
