Activities

Govt. Khawzawl College endeavor to realize its vision of transforming the community and nation

through multifaceted activities and programmes which have been undertaken by NSS cell, NCC,

Student Union, Student Evangelical Union and different clubs.

1. Blood Donation:

The National Voluntary Blood Donation Day – 2022 was observed in the Multi-Purpose Hall, Govt. Khawzawl College on 1st October, 2022 at 10:00 Am. The programme was jointly organized by NSS Units Govt. Khawzawl College, Khawzawl Higher Secondary School and Association for Voluntary Blood Donation Champhai with Blood Centre District Hospital Champhai, Mizoram. A total of 51 Units of Blood donated. Male – 31 Units and Female – 20 units. Of these, Govt. Khawzawl College NSS donated 25 Units, 24 Units from Khawzawl Higher Secondary School and 2 Units from outside.

2. Plantation Activities:

i) In pursuance of the mail received from Mahatma Gandhi National Council for Rural Education, Ministry of India, NSS Units of this College organized MGNCRE WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY, 2022 by building up of a new Nursery which may produce 200 Seedlings annually for the Campus Plantation on 31st May, 2022. 10 Volunteers and 2 POs participated

ii) Green Mizoram Day 2022:

In pursuance of the letter vide No.D.28020/1/2010-DFO(KZL) of Office of the Divisional Forest Officer, Khawzawl Wildlife Division, two NSS POs and eight volunteers of Govt. Khawzawl College participated at the Inaugural Programme on Green Mizoram Day, 2022 in the DC's Office Complex on 10th June, 2022. In the function, the Deputy Commissioner, on behalf of the Mahatma Gandhi National Council for Rural Education, Govt. of India handed over the District Championship Certificate to the Govt. Khawzawl College for their elevation of the swachhta Action Plan, Adoption and implementation of best practice in the area of Sanitation, Hygiene, Waste Management, Water Management, Energy Management and Greenery Management. NSS Unit planted 6 numbers of Seedlings in the DC's Bungalow Complex, Khawzawl.
